Weather changes

As the weather has been dreadful over the last couple of months, we have had to run significantly more sessions than we would have liked on the astros rather than at Pittville. FB is a very effective tool in doing this, so please do join the group if you do use this social media tool.

GDPR

You may be aware that there is new European legislation coming into force in May 2018 relating to personal data (called General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR). This is quite wide reaching, affecting all organisations which hold personal data (including ourselves and similar clubs) and you may notice some small changes in the way that we communicate with you. We are working towards putting together a policy and will be advising all coaches on what they need to do to ensure that we are GDPR compliant.

Season 2018/19

Although it is only March, we are moving towards the end of this season and already thinking about 2018/19. After Easter, subsonline will be updated with a new verification field and we will be asking everyone to log in and check their details, then sign off as reviewed. We ask everyone to go through this process at least once a year to ensure that we have up to date contact and medical details for safeguarding purposes. Please ensure that the subsonline data reflects what is on your child's passport rather than any shortened names. This is because this data is also used to register children with the FA, who then ask for a passport copy for proof of age, and it causes all sorts of angst if the details we have registered are not the same as the passport. Registration will take place with the league for those children old enough (U7 and above) in the first two weeks of August, so subsonline records will need to be verified before then. We appreciate that sometimes children wish to move around or do something else other than football, but if your child does not intend to play with us next season, we would be very grateful if you could let your manager know before 1 August 2018. This avoids us going through the process of registering them with the FA as playing with the club, only to have to them transfer or deregister them. Thank you.
